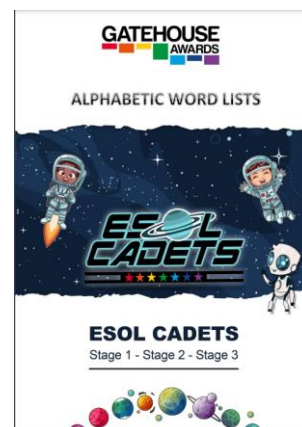
These qualifications are available at Stage 1 (pre-A1), Stage 2 (A1) and Stage 3 (A2).

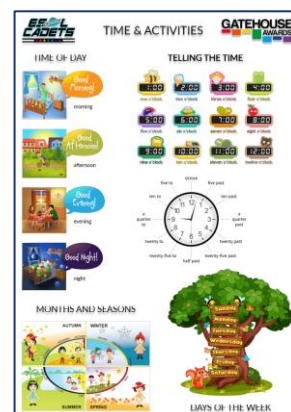

We have produced vocabulary posters with fun and colourful images of a selection of lexical items that the candidates are likely to encounter in our exams. They have been organised into the following categories:

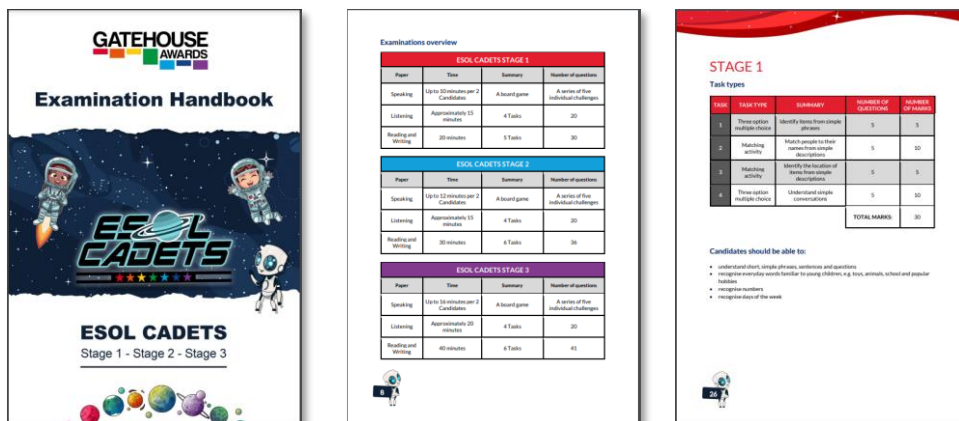

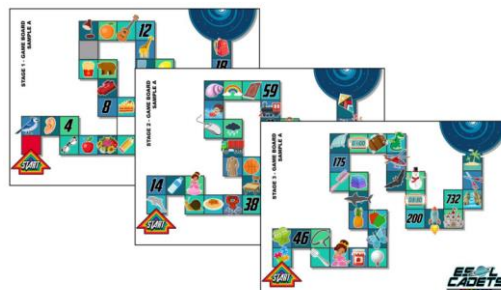

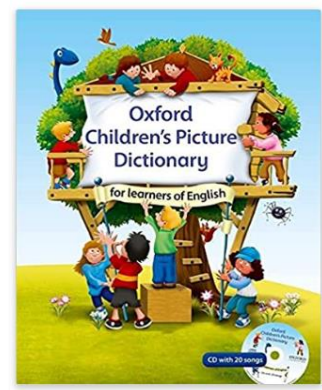

SUPPORT MATERIALS FOR ESOL CADETS STAGE 1

Stage 1 is designed to reflect A0 level, or a *Pre-Entry* level of English. This level is suitable for candidates who are just starting out in learning English. This is also sometimes described as 'Pre-A1' Level, or 'Absolute Beginner'.
